SOCIAL MARKETING STATISTICS 1996

Highlights

Eight new projects crossed the 10,000 Couple-Year-of- Protection (CYP) line in 1996, almost certainly a record number of new social marketing projects in a single year. These eight consisted of programs in five new countries — China, Jordan, Russia, Senegal, and Uzbekistan — plus additional programs in Brazil, India, and Indonesia. India now has five social marketing projects; Brazil, Indonesia, and the Philippines have two each.

The new program in China got off to a roaring start with over 300,000 CYPs in its first full year of operation. This is probably a record. Size of market still matters.

We lost two 1995 projects, those in Burundi and Niger, which dropped below the 10,000 CYP mark.

The net result is 60 programs in 53 countries, an impressive list, even though most of the programs are small.

Despite all of the new activity, the number of couples served by CSM programs grew by just 3% to 14.4 million in 1996. Contributing to the scantiness of this improvement were sharp declines in Nigeria, India II and Venezuela, and a drop in Bangladesh which, while modest in percentage terms, still had a significant impact on the total due to the size of that program. These decrements were partly offset by major increases in China, Pakistan, and Vietnam and by a significant improvement in the Government of India program which regained its status as the world's largest CSM effort. (Bangladesh surpassed India in 1994 and 1995.) The GOI effort has almost fully recovered from a drastic drop in 1994-95, thanks to a new and growing pill component.

Ten programs served more than 5% of their target markets in 1996, against 11 comparably successful programs in 1995.




