

## **NOTES**

1. Abortion is not included in the PRB (or DHS) enumeration and is thus eliminated here. We have also adjusted CYPs for IUDs and implants to reflect current users as well as users from prior years, including a reduction of impact to account for users who may have stopped the method 2. The number of women of reproductive age is based on *all* women of reproductive age, not just those who are married/in a union (which is the denominator in determining CPR). All figures for column D and E are from PRB (2013) except India Bihar-IDHS (2008). 4. DKT's program with headquarters in Mumbai is national in scope. We therefore determine WRA as all of India less Bihar (where a second program is based). The CPR of India/Mumbai comes from India Maharashtra-IDHS (2008).
