• Family Planning High-Impact Practices in Mozambique: an analysis of DKT Mozambique's Mobile Outreach Services from 2021 to 2024

DKT Author: Francisco Chicamisse (DKT Mozambique)

Summary: From 2021 to 2024, DKT Mozambique's mobile outreach significantly increased access to modern contraceptives, serving over 161,000 women annually, including many first-time users, and boosting long-acting reversible contraceptive uptake in underserved areas.
